Randall's Chapel Family,

Some of the fond memories I have from my childhood was going to my grandparents house.

They lived in the Ridgedale community and had a small farm located at the east end of the Scottsboro airport. Many summer afternoons I would sneak off past the barn and through the pasture to the edge of the runway to watch the planes take off and land. Often they would sit at the end of the runway close to me and go through their preflight check list which included holding the brakes and throttling up



the engine causing the plane to shake violently as the air flowed across its surfaces. Then with the brakes released the plane would bolt down the runway and lift off and disappear to some unknown destination or they would simply fly around and land again. I often dreamed about flying and hoped some day to be able to experience flying myself.

Some thirty years later a co-worker invited me to take a flight with him in his plane. Needless to say the next week I began taking lessons with an instructor at the Moon Town airport near Huntsville. For the next six months I spent many lunch breaks and afternoons honing my skills flying the pattern of touch down and go around or flying cross country to a nearby airport. My instructor often gave me in flight test involving emergency situations. While making turns he would often scold me saying "keep your eye on the ball." The "ball" is a small U shaped glass tube with a ball inside that reflects the turn and slip of the plane.
