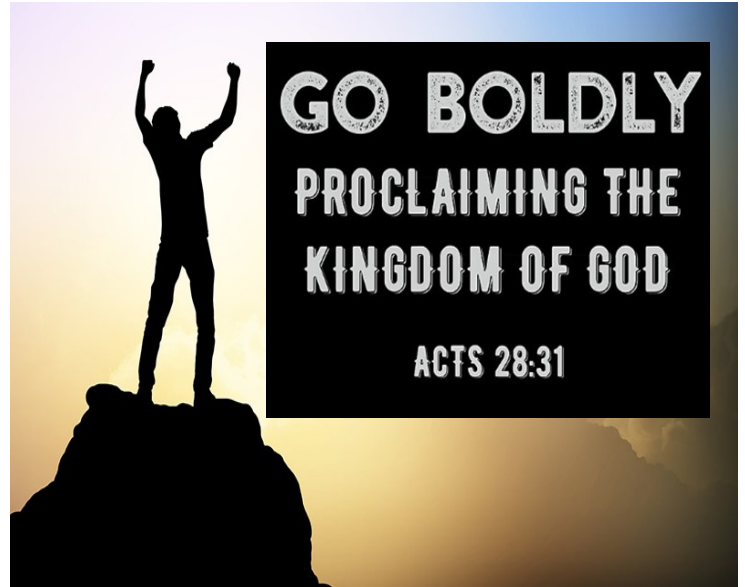

As we read the New Testament, we are confronted with the truth that, as Dr. Winston Worrell put it in his study guide *Becoming More Missional*, "Jesus was constantly building relationships with new persons through word, deed and sign". 11. Jesus taught the Kingdom of God to new people.

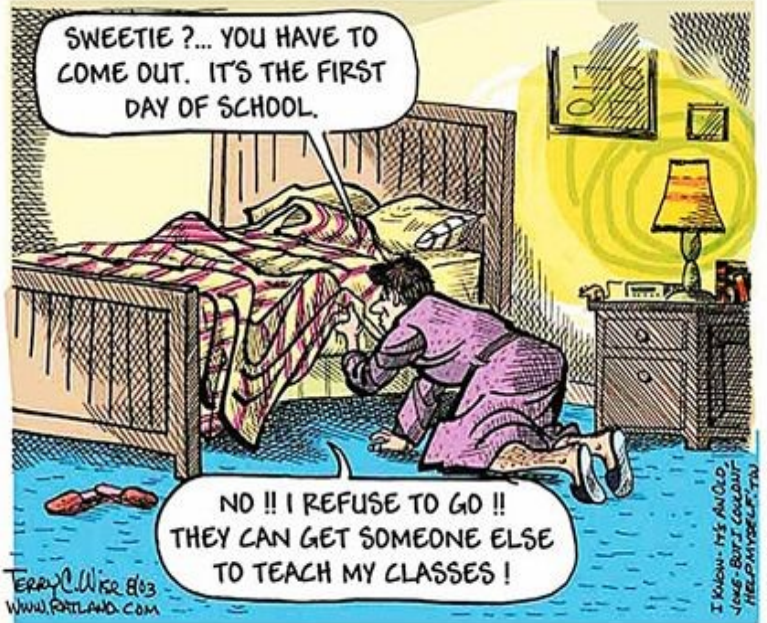

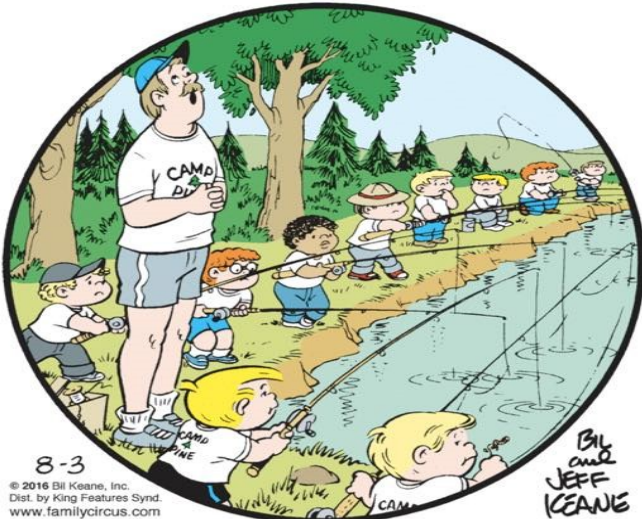
