

Our New Building Project-

As you all know, along with many others of Scottsboro, we are well known as the church that provides free Thanksgiving Meals to the community.

Since I have been here there has been talk that we need a safer and better place to store all the equipment we use for this great mission. If you have been a part of this great outreach, you know what a big task it is to prepare for it. If you have climbed the stairs of the attic, you know the safety issues hauling stuff up and down those steps. This past year we were able to purchase the big grill we cook all the turkeys and hams on. Fortunately, we have been able to store it for a while on another location, for a season.

What has been a concern of many people is that we have a storage building for all of our Thanksgiving Day Meal equipment, and if you don't know, it's a lot.

So the Trustees Committee and a few others have been looking into this for several months. In the best interest of the church, the Trustees Committee presented their plans to the Administrative Council and it was voted on and approved to build this storage building. It was also voted on and approved that we ask all of you of Randall's Chapel UMC to share with the cost of this building project. This will be a great asset to our Thanksgiving Day outreach.

Our plans are to build a 24'x26' metal building on a new concrete slab at the rear of our parking lot. To have two front garage doors and a side door. Electricity and water to be run to the building. There are many more details you can ask a Trustees member about. It seems to be a favorable desire of so many of you. Now the big question is, How much will this cost? Our estimated projected cost is to raise \$18,000.

As your pastor, I ask that you keep this project in your prayers. To seek the Lord as to your financial support with this project. All financial support can be given during our offerings. Please ear-mark your check, 'Thanksgiving Storage Building'. Your prayers and financial support will help continue a great blessing to our community and to the life of Randall's Chapel UMC. Thank you for your support in the past and for it in the future.


