Epiphany is celebrated for 12 days after Christmas. It is the time when Christians remember the Magi, wise men who visited Jesus and gave Him the gifts of gold, myrrh and frankincense. 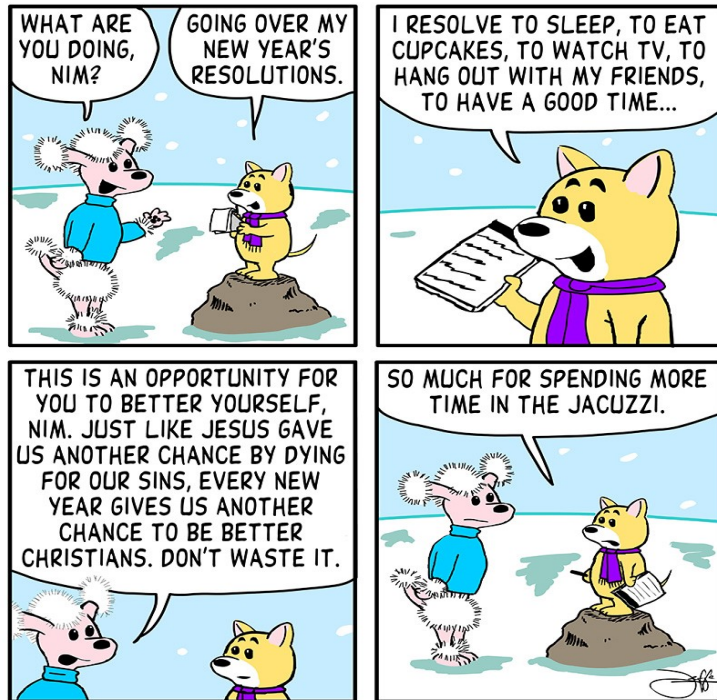

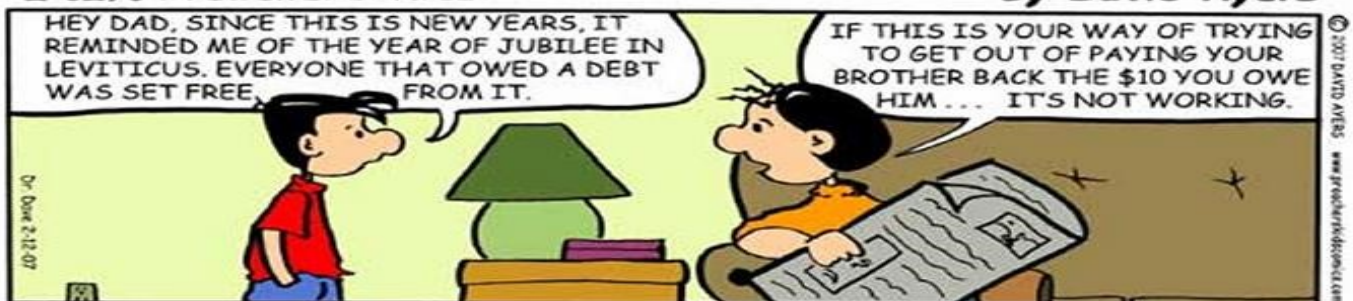
