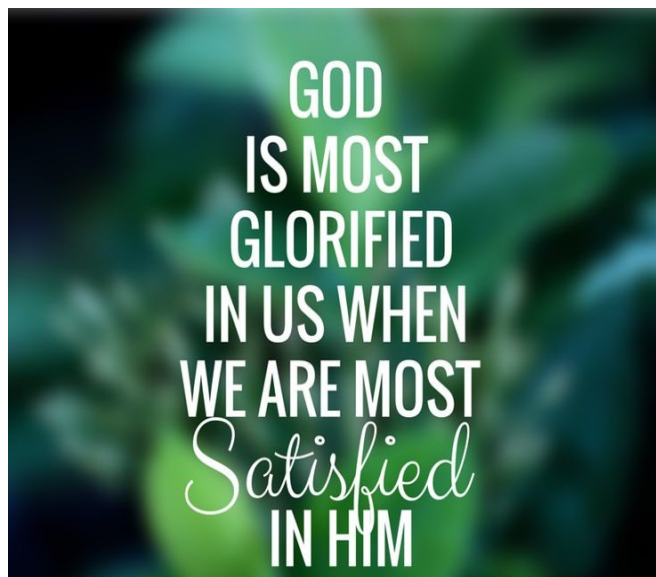


Satisfied?

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Matthew 5:6 (NASB)

I wonder how many of us ate so much during the holiday season that we felt totally gorged with food. The word Jesus used in this beatitude comes from the root word to be so filled that we are gorged. As we sat back at the dinner table, or reclined in our favorite seat, there was this heave of relief and we state we are filled to overflowing; gorged; satisfied. This dictionary tells us that to be satisfied is to be contented and pleased. It makes me wonder, how many of us are truly satisfied?



Jesus, in this beatitude speaks of being one of those who hunger and thirst for righteousness; for the state of being in a right relationship with God. To be doing what God has told us to do. To be walking the path God has called us to walk. To be living in a way that is right with God. To know that if we stood before Him today, He would declare that He is well satisfied with how we have lived Him. From that perspective, in looking at you and our church, would He be satisfied?

As a church we have voted, and I believe it was the right choice for this particular congregation, to disaffiliate from the UMC and go in a direction that more fully exemplifies the belief and practice of the congregation's call. As an individual each of us have had to decide what God would have us do in our own relationship with His church, this local congregation and the greater denomination. And as we each make our choices, I have to ask, are you satisfied?

During the month of January, we are going to ask the question; Are You Satisfied? Are you satisfied with who we are as a church and as believers? Are you satisfied with the path you have chosen for you life eternal? Are you satisfied with your hunger for God and His desire for your life? Are you satisfied in your willingness to hear His voice and call? Are you satisfied with God's call on your life? Are you satisfied?

My prayer is that in all these questions we will be able to say with conviction and a full hearted attitude; "Yes, I am satisfied."

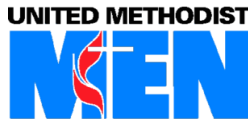

We have had people drop off the Greeters list, so there will no longer be assigned weeks for this position. If you are able to help with this please call the church office.

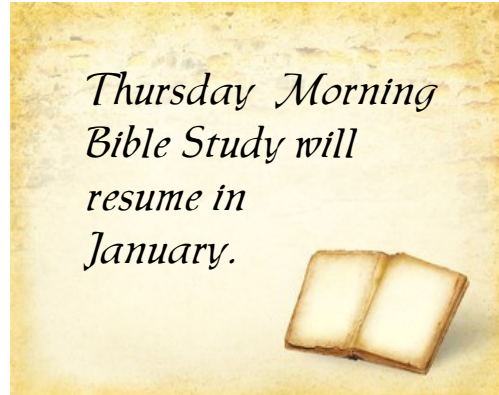

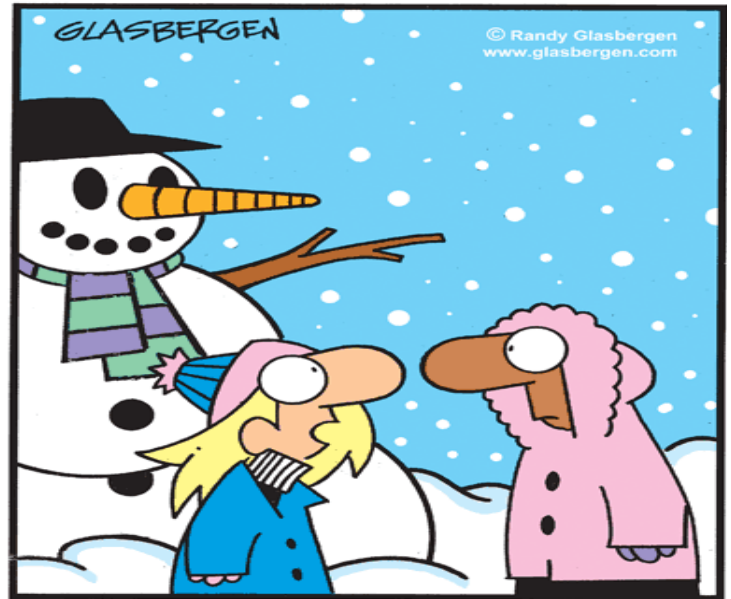

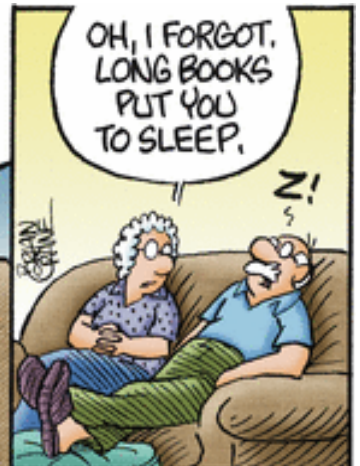
