Freedom -Saturday is the 4th of July! So, Happy Independence

Day! We will be celebrating the birth of our Nation, the United States of America. 244 years ago, our country's forefathers declared their Independence from the British Empire. They had enough of the British Tyranny.

Tyranny, we don't use that word much, but it's meaning is, One who shows cruelty and injustice in the exercise of power or authority over others. We experience Tyranny when we are under the power of an oppressive ruler.



Think of being bullied. So, our forefathers of the American colonies responded with a little announcement to the British Empire. 'Hey, we are announcing the birth of our nation.'

In **Luke 4:18-19**, Jesus begins His ministry by making a Declaration of Independence for us. His announcement? That He has come to set us free ... Jesus quotes **[s. 61**,

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim **freedom** for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

Discipleship Now -






