Grief Support Group



General Conference of the United Methodist Church, May 5-15, 2020

Last year, 2019, there was a 'Called General Conference of the UMC' to hear and vote on proposals for the UMC to change it's Book of Discipline on its stance against ordaining homosexuals and not to preform same sex marriages. No proposals were voted successful, so our stance as a UMC and it's Book of Discipline remain as it is.

Now in 2020, there is again the General Conference of the UMC, which will be May 5-15, 2020 in Minneapolis, Minn. Again, proposals will be heard and voted on to change the Book of Discipline on its stance towards not ordaining homosexuals, nor marrying same sex genders. No changes will be made unless a proposal is voted on and has won the vote to change anything. Yes, there is a lot of talk out there circling about; however, whatever you hear before General Conference in May, we are still the United Methodist Church, making disciples of Jesus Christ. 
