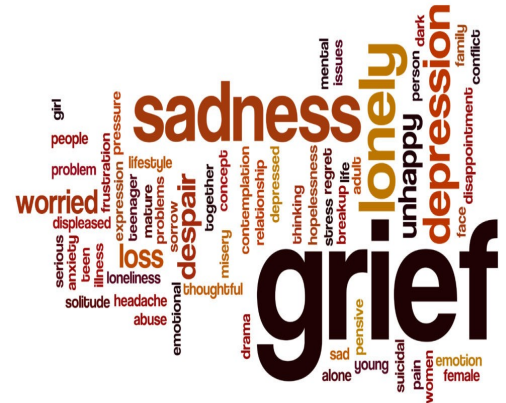

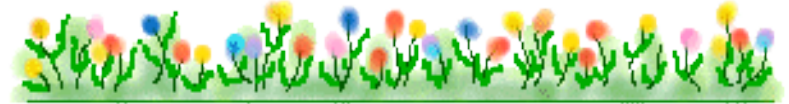

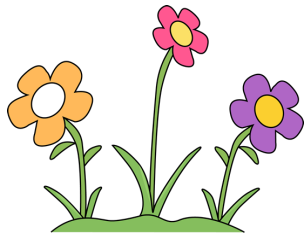
Happy St. Patrick's Day!
