To them God willed to make known what the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. – Colossians 1:27

We have entered into the time of Lent. For many it is a time of reflection, repentance, and renewal. For others it is a time of sacrifice or service. 


