### All Saints Sunday- Nov. 3, 2019

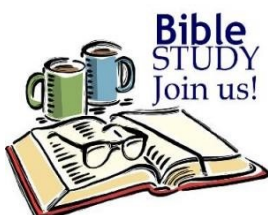
