

A Reminder....

Maybe these past 7 months of 2020 have not been like any March thru September that you can recall. With this Covid-19 rearranging my routine of doing life, there are some things that just about slipped my mind. Have you missed something that was a regular routine in your life because of this pandemic?

I missed the way student graduations once were. I missed the way summer traditionally started for me. I missed that summer activity of VBS. Though the college football season has



started, I missed the buildup I once used to have in August for it. Life is and forever will be changing, and that's something that's a guarantee. I have missed Holy Communion with all of you.

A Reminder – This coming Sunday, October 4th, the first Sunday of the month, we will once again have Holy Common during our 10:00 a.m. worship. It has been a while, not since April 9th on Maundy Thursday of Holy Week, before Easter, have we had Communion together and that was through our Facebook live video. Prior to that it was at church on Sunday, March 1st. Wow! It will be 7 mouths since then, when we take it again Oct. 4th.

I hope you can join us. Here is the plan. We will have worship as we have been at 10:00 a.m. Those preparing Communion for us will as always, wear gloves and they will wear a mask in preparing the bread and juice. Individual pieces of bread will be placed in small individual cups. The small individual plastic cups we use on the Traditional side will be used and held in the brass cup trays, but spaciously arranged to give each person room to pick out a cup without touching other cups.

During worship, when it is time for Holy Communion, you will be instructed to come and receive communion. The elements will be placed on two tables up front. Staying 6 feet apart from others, come forward on the outer aisles and approach the table and take a cup with bread and eat it, then take a cup of juice and drink it. We will have a small trash can for your cups. Then return to your seat by the inner aisles. I hope this will be a very meaningful celebration of Holy Communion for us.

Out of loving respect for others, and being cautious of spreading germs, please wear a mask to receive the elements from the table, thanks.

new part-time position, someone who can lead our worship service and eventfully both the Contemporary and Traditional worship services.






