Savoring the Flavors-

You have probably heard me say it before, when my children were little, they liked to chew up their candy or treats quickly. Me, I like to let a piece of candy or treat just kind of melt in my mouth, savoring its flavor. Sometimes that's what happens when I get into the Scriptures, I just savor the flavor for all it's worth. It happened this morning with a piece of Scripture, Hebrews 12:2. NIV

"Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith..."

It happened, the flavors overwhelmed my taste buds, I began to savor the moment. Different ingredients were used to make this an enjoyable delight. Here's the breakdown of those ingredients.

First, I fixed my eyes on Jesus whom the author of Hebrews said is the Author and Perfecter of my faith. Just what all does that intel?

I've always thought of God as the author, the one who has planned my days, written out the script for my life as long as I walk with Him in His grace. Psalm 139:16. I've also thought of how Jesus is the one who perfects, matures my faith. Being a work in progress.

So, I started reading different translations of Hebrews 12:2. See, the Greek language is so rich, one Greek word can have many English meanings to it.

As I was reading these other translations, here are some of the flavors I was experiencing.

As the Author and Perfecter of our faith, my thoughts were savoring the taste of Jesus being the Pioneer, the Trailblazer, the Example, the Founder of our faith. These were the other Greek meanings for the Author and the Perfecter. Jesus is the One who brings our faith to maturity, to completion.

As I savored these flavors, meditating on what each title means, I experienced a broader scope of who Jesus is, and a broader scope of this passage of Scripture. Try taking a passage of Scripture and Savor it by asking the Holy Spirit to reveal all of its ingredients and flavors to you. 'For the word of God is living and active.' Hebrews 12:4.

I leave you with this passage of Scripture from Psalm 119:103,

"How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth!"

website: www.randallschapel.com and watch it there. If you can't join us at 10:00 a.m. on Sundays, you can go anytime after then and replay the worship.



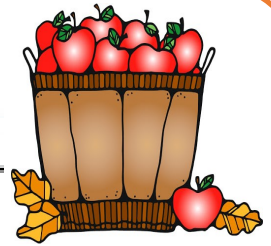
Offerings -

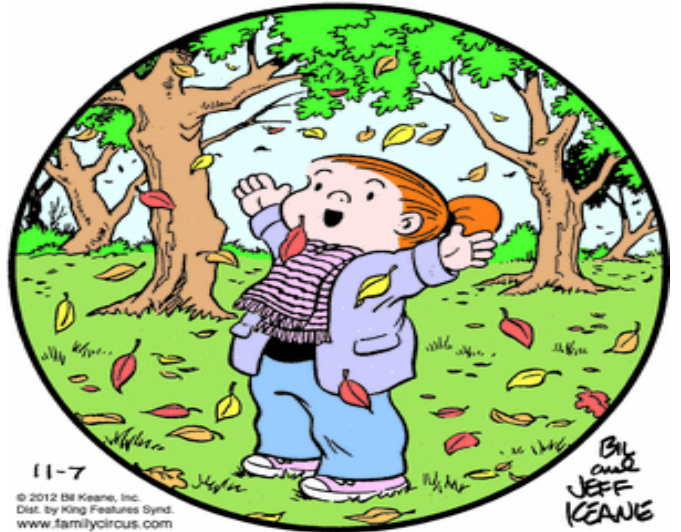

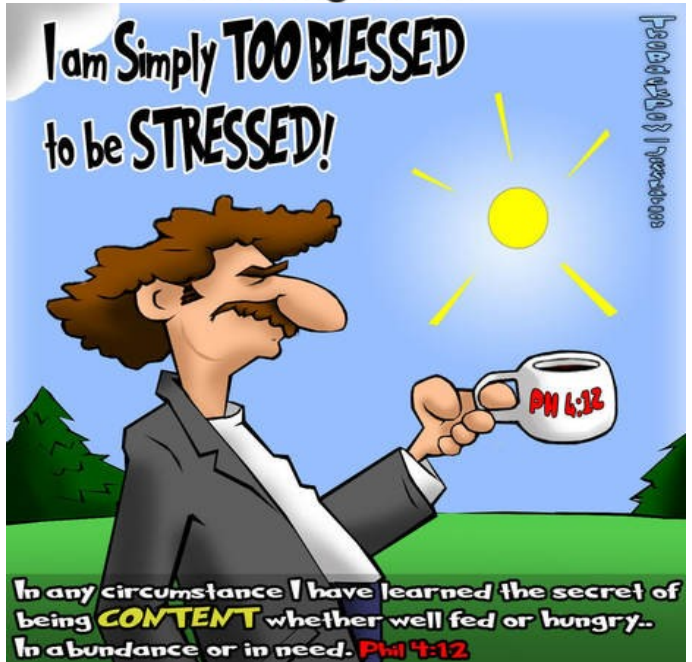
